The mission of the Wyoming Fire Department is to save life and property from fire and other disasters both natural and man-made. This mission will be accomplished by serving the public with dedication, professionalism and sincere integrity; by educating the residents in matters of fire, public safety and emergency preparedness; by providing initial emergency medical care; by insuring that our personnel are fully trained and have the best possible equipment to handle any type of emergency. The pursuit of this goal is tempered only by the responsibility to be prudent caretakers of the public funds entrusted to us.

It is the goal of the Wyoming Fire Department:

- To provide a responsible base of readily available personnel to provide safe fire protection and rescue operation.
- To provide a timely medical response, provide medical stabilization and preparation for transport to a regional medical facility for the citizens of Wyoming and those visiting the City.
- To provide a fire safe community through a comprehensive plan review of new construction and continued monitoring of existing buildings through fire code inspections.
- To provide fire safety education to all ages to proactively reduce future fire loss and enhance public safety knowledge.
