

“Wyoming Safe City”

The Wyoming Fire Department will be offering “Wyoming Safe City” again this summer. This year’s Safe City will be a one-week, 2-hours per day program designed to teach children about safe practices in many areas. Some of the areas of instruction will include bicycle safety, fire safety, pool safety and rules of the road. The program is designed for children ages 5 – 7 years old.

Safe City sessions will be offered four times this summer. The dates this year are **June 8 – 12, 2009 and July 6 - 10, 2009. Sessions will be held from 10:00 a.m. until noon and 1:00 p.m. until 3:00 p.m. The June sessions will be held at Station #1, 1500 Burton SW. The July sessions will be held at Station #3, 2300 Gezon.** There will be a cost of \$5.00 per child, which may be sent in with your registration.
