




DO YOU KNOW WHERE YOUR PROPERTY TAX DOLLARS GO?

The City of Wyoming is known for its beautiful parks, excellent infrastructure, numerous educational opportunities and diverse business offerings. The community investment you make through your tax dollars supports all of these features that make Wyoming a wonderful place to live, work and play. For every \$1 paid in taxes, you contribute to all of the entities listed below.

The average home in the Grandville school district has a taxable value of \$87,300. Based on current millage rates, the total tax bill for this property would be \$3,206.36, and each entity would receive the following:



The City of Wyoming **receives 32.1¢** for every tax dollar paid, or **\$1039.51 of the total tax bill**. The City's funds are allocated as follows:
