Section 50-236

Accosting, molesting, or annoying others: It shall be unlawful for any person to accost, molest, or otherwise annoy, either by word of mouth, whistle or by sign or motion, any person in any public place or place open to the public.

Section 50-110 (abbreviated)

Fraud or Forgery: It shall be unlawful for any person who, with intent to defraud or cheat, by false pretense obtain from any person any money or personal property valued at \$100.00 or less.

Michigan Motor Vehicle Code 257.676b

Interference with normal flow of vehicular or pedestrian traffic prohibited; exception: violation as civil infraction.

- 1) A person, without authority, shall not block, obstruct, impede, or otherwise interfere with the normal flow of vehicular or pedestrian traffic upon a public street or highway in this state, by means of a barricade, object, or device, or with his or her person. This section shall not apply to persons maintaining, rearranging, or constructing public utility facilities in or adjacent to a street or highway.
- 2) A person who violates this section is responsible for a civil infraction.
