## WYOMING POLICE ARREST TWO SUSPECTS DURING BREAK-IN AT HIGH SCHOOL

At approximately 1:15 a.m. on July 20, 2013, two Wyoming police officers were checking the Wyoming High School property when they noticed a bicycle leaning against the building. Upon further investigation, officers discovered that one of the doors to the school had been forced open. Once inside, officers used a K9 to search the building which resulted in two suspects climbing out a window where they were subsequently taken into custody. While inside the school, officers discovered that the suspects caused damage to property throughout the building.

On July 22, Michael Allen Lanning, 38, and Cullen Shae Johnston, 18, were arraigned in the Wyoming 62A District Court on the following charges:


COUNT 1 – Breaking & Entering (5-year felony)

COUNT 2 – Malicious Destruction of Property (5-year felony)

Cullen Johnston was also charged with a second count of Breaking & Entering for his involvement in a burglary at the school just two days prior on July 18, 2013.
