WYOMING SENIOR CENTER HOSTS SUPERINTENDENT FORUM SERIES IN 2013

WYOMING, MI, February 1, 2013 – The Wyoming Senior Center will begin hosting a Superintendent’s Forum Series this year. The intent of the series is to offer superintendents whose school districts serve the citizens of Wyoming, the opportunity to speak to and answer questions from area residents. The City of Wyoming is unique in that the city is served by multiple public school districts, rather than just one main district, so the series provides an opportunity for the participating superintendents to talk specifically about their district and its relationship with the City of Wyoming.

The series kicks off on Tuesday, February 19 at 10:00 am with Godfrey-Lee Public School Superintendent, David Britten talking about the changes in their district from its rural roots to today, a period of over 155 years. His talk will focus on how the district remains a critical hub of the community and the impact it has not only to the residents, but also businesses in the Burton Street and Chicago Drive area that is within the district.

While the series will take place at the Wyoming Senior Center, a facility with programs and activities to meet the physical, mental and social needs of those 50 years of age and older, it is open to anyone who would like to attend regardless of age. The Wyoming Senior Center is located at 2380 DeHoop Avenue.

“Our parks and recreation master plan process has identified the desire of community members to gain information about issues that impact their lives,” according to Rebecca Rynbrandt, Director of Community Services for the City of Wyoming. “Education is certainly high on that list for the community. This is a launching point for future speaker engagements that could cover topics like poverty, community safety, employment, transportation along with health and wellness,” adds Rynbrandt.

Tuesday, April 30 is tentatively scheduled as the next Superintendent’s Forum, with Kelloggsville Public Schools superintendent Greg Warsen slated to speak.
