



# Pinery Park

2301 DeHOOP

## AVAILABLE ~

Lodge: Open year round.

Shelter and Sections: May 1 - September 30.

Lodge, shelter, two picnic sections, grills, softball field, tennis courts, basketball courts, pickleball courts, fitness trail (1 mile), and playground equipment.

## LODGE ~

Seats 144. Heated building with full kitchen (no utensils), fireplace (you provide wood), includes electricity, tables with attached seats, and restrooms.



# Special / Athletic Events

Facilities are available for athletic or special event usage. If a reservation has an expected attendance of more than 200 people, special maintenance is required or if you desire the use of special equipment not provided by the Parks & Recreation Department (inflatable games, carnival-type games, petting zoos, etc.), a Special/Athletic Event application is required.

## SECTION A ~

Accommodates 300. Includes grounds northeast of the lodge to the playground area.

## OPEN SHELTER ~

Accommodates 50.

## SECTION C ~

Accommodates 125. North end of the park, north of the north playground and east of Section A.

# Ideal Park

## AVAILABLE ~

May 1 - September 30

Lodge, shelter, four picnic sections, grills, softball field, tennis courts, basketball courts, walking trail, fishing, soccer fields and playground.

## LODGE ~

Seats 60. Includes picnic tables and electricity.

## OPEN SHELTER ~

Accommodates 100. Includes electricity, water, and grills. Restrooms at the end of the shelter. Located west of Section A near playground.

## SECTION A ~

Accommodates 150. Includes low grounds west of creek and east of shelter.

## SECTION B ~

Accommodates 150. Includes low grounds west of creek, just south of footbridge.

## SECTION C ~

Accommodates 200. Includes low grounds along west side of creek from cement bridge south and east of lodge.

## SECTION D ~

Accommodates 125. Includes low grounds along west side of creek from cement bridge north.

# Lamar Park

## AVAILABLE ~

May 1 - September 30

Shelter, three picnic sections, grills, splashpad, lake, fishing, playground, softball fields, baseball field, basketball courts, sand volleyball courts, soccer fields, tennis courts, climbing wall, and walking trail (1/2 mile).

## OPEN SHELTER ~

Seats 75. Includes electricity.

## SECTION A ~

Accommodates 300. Includes grounds along north side of creek, north of the lighted softball field.

## SECTION B ~

Accommodates 125. Includes grounds along south side of main parking lot, south of the shelter.

## SECTION C ~

Accommodates 75. Includes grounds on the west side of the park, west of Section A and east of the small parking lot.



## ATHLETIC FACILITIES

We now offer select athletic facilities for rent such as baseball and softball fields, basketball courts, tennis courts, volleyball courts, and soccer fields.

  - ☑ Fireworks
  - ☑ Smoking in Buildings
  - ☑ Golf Activities
