The Splashpad features a number of unique design elements that make it universally accessible to children and adults of all abilities. The water playground is 115 feet long and 82 feet wide.

Features include:

 Interactive play space featuring soaker stations, a water tunnel, fire hydrant and dumping buckets in a variety of bright, vibrant colors.

 Areas dedicated to various developmental phases, with appropriate activities to appeal to particular ages and abilities.

# Lamar Park Splashpad



The Splashpad is activated manually by pressing the button on top of the red fire hydrant or with the foot pedal near the water rings. It runs on a timer of approximately 10-15 minutes. The water

fun rotates from one water station to another, ensuring everyone will get there fair share of refreshing cool water.

~Available for use in one hour increments, with a maximum of four hours

~\$100/Refundable damage deposit made by check or credit card

~Reservations must be made at least 24 hours in advance

~Reservations can be made for the hours between 10am and 7pm

~Chair must be returned to a park attendant to ensure return of deposit
