RESOLUTION TO APPROVE AN APPLICATION FOR AN INDUSTRIAL FACILITIES EXEMPTION CERTIFICATE IN THE CITY OF WYOMING FOR STOCKWELL MANUFACTURING CO. AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO SIGN THE IFT AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, Stockwell Manufacturing Co. has submitted an application for an Industrial Facilities Exemption Certificate pursuant to the provisions of Act 198, Public Acts of 1974, as amended, for new machinery and equipment with an estimated cost of \$3,000,000.00 for personal property, and

WHEREAS, the new machinery and equipment will be located at 4971 Clay Avenue SW, Wyoming, Michigan and will be within Industrial Development District Number 111 established by Resolution Number 11607 adopted on September 3, 1985, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing on whether to approve the Certificate was held on December 6, 2010, at 7:01 p.m., in the Council Chambers, City Hall, 1155 28th Street SW, Wyoming, Michigan at which the applicant, the Assessor, and all affected taxing units were given an opportunity to be heard on the application, and

WHEREAS, completion of the project has the reasonable likelihood to retain, create, or prevent the loss of employment in the City of Wyoming, and



Cherry Street Health Services (CSHS), is a non-profit 501(C) (3), Community Health Center that provides primary health care services to 50,000 patients in Grand Rapids inner city and surrounding communities extending throughout Kent, Montcalm and Ionia Counties, Michigan. Services are delivered at 4 community sites, 4 partnership sites, 4 school sites and through a traveling school program to 68 schools. CSHS is federally and state funded serving the needs of the underserved since 1988, with a history of commitment and service to the homeless and migrant communities. CSHS served 2,302 homeless individuals in 2008, and that number jumped to 3,116 in 2009.

CSHS is seeking to fund two additional section 330 satellite Community Health Center sites serving the homeless and other low income patients on the southwest side of Grand Rapids and in Wyoming, Michigan. The Wyoming and southwest Grand Rapids service area (census tracts 26, 28, 31, 35-40, 133-135, 137, 138.01 and 138.02) has a population of 64,293 (2009). The Grand Rapids area has been devastated by a major loss of employment recently, impacting incomes, health insurance, ability to access health services, and poverty rates. In 2009, Grand Rapids had 46% and Wyoming had 37% of their populations living below 200% of the poverty level. This compares to 35% and 23% respectively in 2000. In 2009, 32.4% of the Wyoming/southwest Grand Rapids population was below 100% of the federal poverty level.

According to the Grand Rapids Area Coalition to End Homelessness, of which Cherry Street Health Services is a Core Partner, over 5000 people in Grand Rapids were homeless in 2009. CSHS' 2010 patient data through early November show 671 homeless from zip codes 49507, 49509 and 49548, the target area for this proposal. Patients identified these geographic areas where they were either doubled up with another family, in transitional housing or a shelter, or living on the streets. Major issues that will be addressed for this community include a higher than state average on infant mortality, increase in preventable hospitalizations, inadequacy of prenatal care, low birth weight, chronic illness, infectious diseases and a high rate of unintentional injuries.

The service delivery sites will be located in Wyoming, just off 28th Street on the western part of the service area, and on Kalamazoo Street in Grand Rapids on the eastern part of the service area. Both locations will be able to meet the 25% homeless requirements, based on the number of homeless already being seen from this geographic area in 2010 (671) as a percentage of all new patients anticipated (2,400; described below). Patients will receive comprehensive, culturally competent, quality primary health care services, including oral health, mental health and substance abuse services. In the first year, staff covering both sites will include 1 FTE Family Practice Physician, 1 Physician Assistant, 1 FTE Dentist, 1 FTE Hygienist, and clinical support staff, for a total of 9.5 FTE. In the second year staff will include 1.5 FTE Family Practice Physicians, 1 FTE Physician Assistant, 1.5 FTE Dentists, 1 FTE Hygienist, 0.5 FTE MSW, and clinical support staff. The project will bring medical care services to 2,400 new patients, including pregnant women, with 7,500 visits in the first year and 12,000 visits in the second year. The project will provide 3,000 preventative and restorative dental visits each year. Just over 25% of the patients are expected to be homeless, primarily recent immigrants who are doubled up with relatives or friends. CSHS will leverage existing relationships with other community groups and providers who serve the homeless to provide effective outreach, translation and other enabling services that will be tailored to meet specific needs.



SUBJECT: Replacement Utility Boxes and Tops

On Tuesday November 9, 2010 the City received six (6) bid responses for two (2) utility boxes with covers to be installed on replacement vehicles for the Public Works Department and the Meter Shop. Six invitations to bid were sent to prospective bidders. Three companies submitted bids that met the specifications. Three companies, Hoekstra Truck Equipment, Monroe Truck Equipment and Arista Truck Systems each made a number of exceptions to the bid specifications.

The exceptions taken by the three bidders were with respect to dimensions and material thickness. The dimensional exceptions would reduce the size of the boxes and not allow the users to carry the equipment they need to complete their task. The material thickness exceptions would reduce the strength and may lead to the premature failure of the boxes

A tabulation of the bids received is shown below.

ORDINANCE NO. 11-10

AN ORDINANCE TO ADD SECTION 90-66
TO THE CODE OF THE CITY OF WYOMING

THE CITY OF WYOMING ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 90-66 is hereby added to the Code of the City of Wyoming to read as follows:

Sec. 90-66. USES PROHIBITED BY LAW. Uses not expressly permitted under this Ordinance are prohibited in all districts. Uses that are contrary to federal law, state law or local ordinance are prohibited.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect on the 21st day of December, 2010.
